Although the bridges were designed for snowmobile traffic they will benefit all types of year round use including walking, hiking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. Thanks to all the volunteers who made it out to help support our new trail system, but more importantly to help build multi-use trails for the benefit of everyone. CPBSC is making a difference in our community- not just for snowmobiling but for all.



**Snowmobile Club Membership Drive**

CPBSC is actively pursuing new members.
